

## Best Paper Award Economic and Social History

On the occasion of the 3rd Congress for Economic and Social History in Regensburg (20-22 March 2019), the Wissenschaftsförderung der *Sparkassen-Finanzgruppe e. V.* for the first time advertises the

### “Best Paper Award Economic and Social History”.

Eligible for this award are all accepted presentations

- whose written version will have been sent to Sibylle Lehmann-Hasemeyer (sibylle.lehmann@uni-hohenheim.de) until 1 March, 2019,
- whose author is working or preparing his or her doctoral thesis at a research institution in Germany, Austria, or Switzerland (in the case of several authors: at least one), and
- whose author has received his or her doctorate not before 1 April, 2013, the date of oral examination, or has not yet accomplished the doctoral thesis (holds for all authors).

Presentations are eligible for this award irrespective of their thematic, temporal, and spatial focus. The following criteria will be guiding selection: contribution to the debate on economic and social history; innovativeness of the research question, the approach or the method; and originality of the source or data base (analysis). A joint committee of the *Wirtschaftshistorischer Ausschuss* and the *Gesellschaft für Sozial- und Wirtschaftsgeschichte* (GSWG) will be conducting the evaluation. The committee consists of Sibylle Lehmann-Hasemeyer for the GSWG, Laura Rischbieter for the *Ausschuss*, and Mark Spoerer as local organiser.

The award is endowed with 1,000 € and will be awarded on the evening of 20 March. It is planned to continue advertising this award at the biennial Congress of Economic and Social History in the future.
